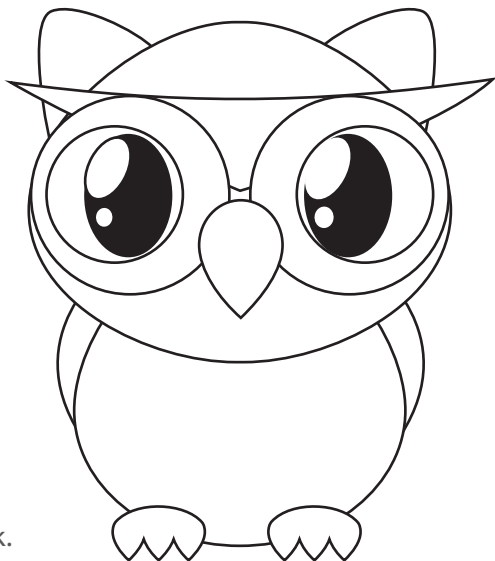


Night time

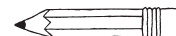

Meteors and shooting stars

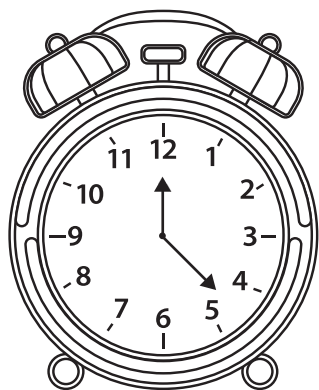


A meteor or shooting star is a brief streak of light in the night sky. They are pieces of rock from space that burn up when they enter the Earth's atmosphere.
