## The Dairy Farm

Milk is produced by cows on dairy farms. The milk collects in their udders. They need to be milked twice a day.


At milking time the cows walk from their pastures to the milking sheds. They wait for their turn to be milked. Their udders are checked and washed. Then milking machines are attached to the cows teats. The milk flows into collection tanks then the milk is stored at a low temperature.

Each day milk is transported in refrigerated tanks to the milk factory. These are some of the collection tanks at the milk factory where the milk will be treated. It is pasteurized to kill any bacteria, then homogenized to mix the cream through the milk.

Finally, it is packaged in bottles or cartons ready for us to drink. We love milk!
