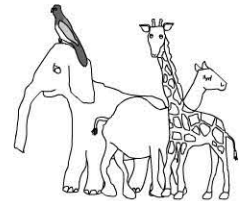

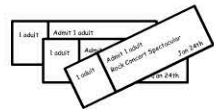
- 1) 9872 people went to the zoo on Saturday. 1048 less people went the next day. How many went to the zoo on Sunday? \_\_\_\_\_
