Some words are more specific in meaning and are more precise in expressing an idea.

To describe something as big, we need to choose a word that indicates the degree of size.

Note that things can be "big" in mass or in height. Some words are better suited to describe mass. Others relate more to height. colossal

#### happy:

cheerful, merry, joyful, gleeful, jovial, delighted, satisfied, buoyant, ecstatic, euphoric, blissful

#### noisy:

loud, thunderous, blaring, deafening, ear-splitting, booming.

#### shining:

sparkling, glittering, dazzling, glitzy, gleaming, flashing, shimmering, luminous, glossy, glinting, lustrous.
