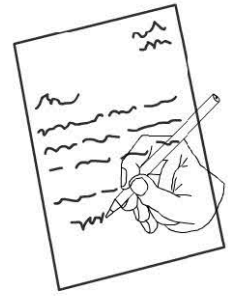

- ★ The introduction - Why you are writing to them.

- ★ Next write all the reasons you can think of that supports your argument. Remember you are trying to convince them to stop with their plan.  
eg. *The reasons I disagree are:*
  1. *The park is a safe place where children like to play. My children and all their friends play together at the park. Taking this away from them means they have one less place to play.*
