




Cars move very quickly. You need to cross the road in a safe place.




Let's learn to cross the road safely.




A pedestrian crossing is a safe place to cross the road.




First stand at the kerb. You need to be sure the drivers can see you.


Some drivers might not see you. Do not cross until you are sure they will stop.



Check the road in both directions to see that the cars are stopping for you.



Walk sensibly across the road.


There is no need to run.
