# Monarch Butterfly Life Cycle

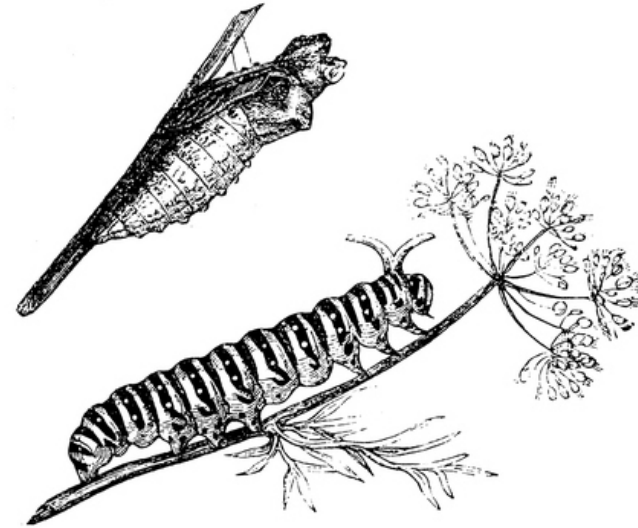
