

Sentences

A sentence is a group of words that has a complete meaning. It tells us what is happening and who or what is taking part.

Example:

The children are playing basketball.

Who: The children

What: are playing basketball

Sentences can have more information.

The children played basketball **at the park.**

The children played basketball at the park **near their homes.**



Capital Letters

All sentences start with a **capital letter**.

Today is my birthday.

On Wednesday we are going to the zoo.

A a

Full Stops

Most sentences end with a **full stop**.

Jack and Mary went to their grandmother's place for dinner.

Today is the last day of school for this term.

Question Marks

A **question mark** is used at the end of a sentence that is a question.

What is your name?

How old is your dog?



Exclamation Marks

Exclamation marks are used at the end of a sentence to show strong feelings.

What a surprise!

That is horrible!
