
To retell events that the speaker has not necessarily been involved in.

Examples of Different Types of Recounts:

biographies, newspaper reports, documentaries, historical accounts and news broadcasts



Structure:

- 1) Orientation:
 - Introductory information about who, what, where and when the event occurred.
- 2) <u>Series of Events:</u>
 Series of paragraphs that retell the events in chronological order.
- 3) Reorientation:

A personal comment about the event.

Structural Features:

- * Use a title.
- * Organise by paragraphs.

Language Features:

- * Use descriptive words.
- * Use technical language where appropriate.
- * Use second or third person pronouns like "you", "they", "he", "she".
- * Use verbs in past tense.
- * Use time connectives to show sequence.

Questions to Ask Yourself:

What happened? Where did it happen? When did it happen? Who was involved? What happened first? What happened next?
