Popsicle Stick Photo Frame

What you will need:

- 4 popsicle sticks (the tongue depressor size)
- Hot glue gun
- Paint and Paintbrush
- White or Coloured sheet of cardboard
- Scissors
- Decorations: eg. crayons, pencils, glitter, stickers, paint, ribbon etc

Directions:

Step 1:

Glue 4 popsicle sticks together using the hot glue gun to form a square frame.

Step 2:

Paint the frame and let it dry completely. Then add some decorations to the frame.

Step 3:

Cut a square piece of cardboard to fit on the back of your popsicle stick frame. (Approximately $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " by $4 \frac{1}{2}$ ")

Step 4:

Ask students to draw a picture on the cardboard. A good suggestion would be a picture of them with their dad or something similar. Then on the back of the cardboard write or help the student to write a nice personal message for their Dad for Father's Day.

Step 5:

Then, put a dot of glue in each corner on the back of the popsicle frame and place the cardboard with the picture side up on the glue to attach it to the frame.

Step 6:

Finally, attach some string to either corner of the top of the frame or a magnet to the back which allows it to be displayed at home on a wall or on the fridge.
